Any visit to central London will reward you as the architectural icons featured in a thousand guide books appear in three stunning dimensions.


St Paul's Cathedral, the Shard, Tower Bridge and the Gherkin are among the most globally recognised of London's landmarks, but the fame goes further and deeper with award-winning theatre, West End shopping, an amazing diversity of restaurants and a rich history and culture that spans centuries.

From Spring, it's all so accessible. London's West End begins at Marble Arch, the gateway to Mayfair, Soho and Covent Garden and just five direct road miles from Spring. The overground service that links Euston to nearby Harlesden station takes as little as 16 minutes, or hop on the tube and take your pick of the

hundreds of destinations available via the underground network.

Spread your wings, spring into action and discover for yourself why London is considered the most stimulating and cosmopolitan city in the world.

Wembley has reinvented itself in recent years; the stadium has always been the main headquarters of the England football team, but these days this lively region offers far more than world class sport.

Over the last decade the area has had a dramatic facelift supported by a regeneration budget of over £40 million, and it's still continuing.

The graceful outline of Wembley's iconic arch is visible from miles around, and acts as a homing beacon now not only for sport and music fans, but for shopping addicts, foodies and cinema lovers too.

The stadium hosts over 150 sporting and live music events every year, while the adjacent Wembley Arena is a showcase for the best acts from the international music scene.

The newly opened London Designer Outlet offers top name brands at hard-to-resist prices, restaurants, cafés and a cinema; there are retail parks, superstores and an enormous IKEA at nearby Brent Park.

And the really good news? It's just one underground stop from Stonebridge Park to Wembley Central or a quick 10 minute trip to Wembley Park by car.







West London has always been the definition of picturesque; these upmarket suburbs exude a timeless appeal with classic architecture, pretty parks, fine wining and dining and top-notch shopping. All can be reached by train, tube or bus and are also within 30 pedal-powered minutes.

Notting Hill is eccentric and bohemian, home to Europe's biggest street festival and the captivating Portobello Market. Browse the stalls for antiques, vintage fashion and retro memorabilia at this great British institution. Whilst Charming Chiswick retains a village ambience with quaint, tree-lined streets, riverside walks, a calm yet cosmopolitan vibe and a good supply of quirky, independent shops.

Green open spaces are always in demand and never in short supply in West London; visit Ealing Common or Gunnersbury Park, take a picnic, read the papers and slow the pace to leisurely. Or at the opposite end of the spectrum, head to one of the biggest and liveliest of London's shopping centres at Westfield in Shepherd's Bush. Make a day of it, and choose from more than 300 retail outlets and 25 restaurants positioned to please every purse and palate, just 15 minutes away on the overground.


JUST GET UP AND GO

Whether it's business or pleasure that takes you to London's centre, with Spring as your base, the trip is never a trek. With a choice of underground and overground routes, you can plan your journey for speed and precision for any time of the day and much of the night.

London's famous Theatreland is focused around Shaftesbury Avenue and Soho, easily accessed by a direct trip on the Bakerloo line service to Piccadilly Circus or Charing Cross. Opt for a matinee performance to allow time to party on in one of the many eclectic bars or clubs in Covent Garden.

Oxford Circus brings you to Oxford and Regent Streets, two of London's best loved and most frequented shopping highways. Or seek out some of the lesser known gems: the Duck and Waffle on the 40th floor of Heron Tower, the quirky Kerb street food market by the Gherkin, the Champagne bar on the Grand Terrace at St Pancras International. Oh, and while you're there, pick up a Eurostar ticket for that weekend break in Paris.

PUT A SPRING IN YOUR STEP

Spring is just an 8 minute walk from Harlesden Station and marginally further from Stonebridge Park. The former will serve you well for journeys towards and into central London; the latter is best suited for destinations north to Wembley, Harrow or Watford.

The choice of underground and overground services gives you a wide list of direct destinations – from Euston and Baker Street to Oxford Circus, Piccaodilly Circus and Waterloo. But a single interchange brings almost the entire London region within easy grasp – and it's all out there, waiting to be explored.
